
A Message from Ken Bever, President



As we enter our 28th year, I am thrilled to see many outstanding young Christian leaders today who began in destitute situations. We see God's hand at work as we partner with our compassionate donors to nurture, educate, and train more than 3,000 at-risk children every day. Unfortunately, this past year brought about an increase in armed gangs throughout Port-au-Prince which has created a dangerous environment for our children and our staff. In addition, my dear friend and in-country director Jeantyard Elmera passed away suddenly in September. Despite these obstacles, we were very blessed have a trusted, courageous, and resilient Haitian team who put forth a tremendous effort to rise up to operate all of our programs this past year.

On the U.S. side, for the 10th year in a row, Charity Navigator, the leading charity rating agency in the U.S., has given us their highest rating (4 stars) and for the 7th straight year a Perfect 100. We continue to value financial transparency and accountability – resulting in top honors in 2022 from the charity research firms Excellence in Giving and Guidestar. These awards come from a talented, passionate staff and board who stretch every dollar we receive from our caring partners who are transforming lives now and for eternity.

Through Christian orphanages, medical services, feeding programs, special gift outreach, and crisis relief efforts, Hope for Haiti's Children (HFHC) provides essential care for at-risk children.

Educate

Hope for Haiti's Children partners with ten locally operated Christian schools in Haiti to assist in the education of the students. Through the HFHC Child Education Sponsorship program, a caring sponsor financially supports a child in need. Providing tuition for students enables the school to retain quality teachers and to supply a uniform and school supplies to each student. Additionally, HFHC funds vital capital projects to enhance the learning environment of each school.

Train

Hope for Haiti's Children supports after-school enrichment classes, vocational training programs, and Christian camp experiences to deepen students' knowledge base and life skills. This prepares young people to lead in their homes, churches, and communities.

24 teens received leadership awards at Camp Hope in 2022




