A Message from Ken Bever, President

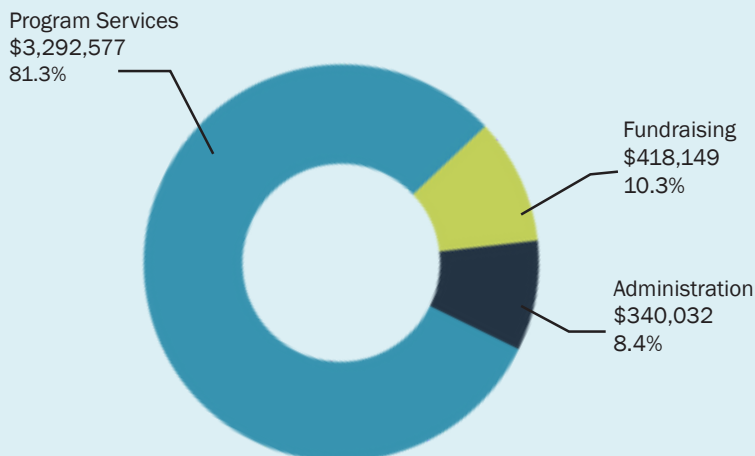


As we enter our 29th year, I am thrilled to see many outstanding Christian leaders because of Hope for Haiti's Children. We see God's hand at work as we partner with our compassionate donors to nurture, educate, and train more than 3,000 at-risk children. Unfortunately, this past year has seen the rise of violent gangs in Port-au-Prince. Our children and staff are caught in a "civil war" between gang leaders, various political factions, and wealthy oligarchs living in the mountains above Port-au-Prince. With 100% of operations run by local, trusted Haitian Christians, we have not run from this crisis. Instead, **we are committed even more** to helping our sponsored children and families survive this crisis.

On the U.S. side, Charity Navigator, the leading charity rating agency in the U.S., has given us their highest rating **(4 stars)**, for the 11th year in a row. We continue to value financial transparency and accountability – resulting in top honors in 2023 from the charity research firms Excellence in Giving, Great Non-Profits, and Guidestar. On average since 2002, 88 cents of every dollar donated is spent on programs directly impacting children in Haiti.

We value your continued partnership in this important, life-giving work.

Through Christian orphanages, medical services, feeding programs, special gift outreach, and crisis relief efforts, Hope for Haiti's Children (HFHC) provides essential care for at-risk children.

Educate

Hope for Haiti's Children partners with ten locally operated Christian schools in Haiti to assist in the education of the students. Through the HFHC Child Education Sponsorship program, a caring sponsor financially supports a child in need. Providing tuition for students enables the school to retain quality teachers and to supply a uniform and school supplies to each student. Additionally, HFHC funds vital capital projects to enhance the learning environment of each school.

Train

Hope for Haiti's Children supports after-school enrichment classes, vocational training programs, and Christian camp experiences to deepen students' knowledge base and life skills. This prepares young people to lead in their homes, churches, and communities.

5 communities hosted local youth rallies for Camp Hope campers

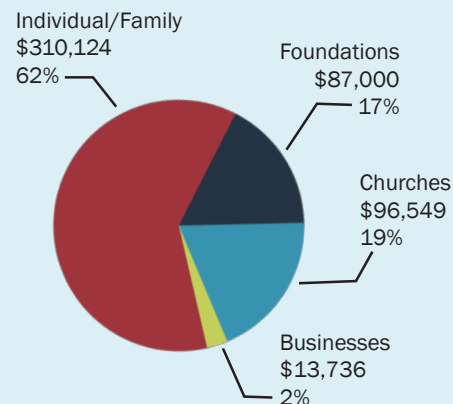


2023 PROJECT HOPE GIFT MATCH CAMPAIGN
