A Message from Ken Bever, President

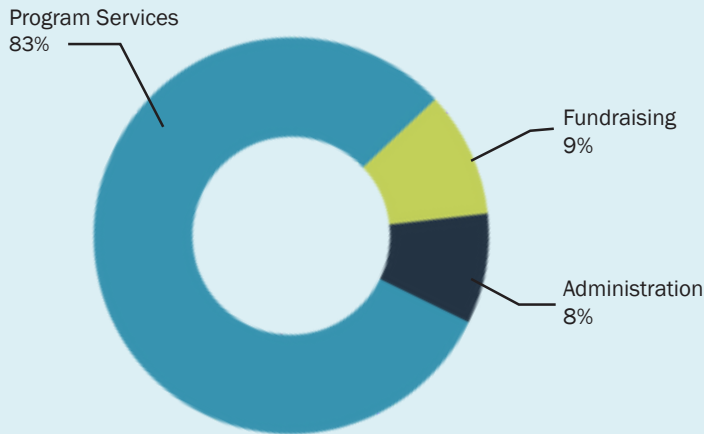


As we enter our 30th year, I am thrilled to see many outstanding Christian leaders because of Hope for Haiti's Children. We see God's hand at work as we partner with our compassionate donors to nurture, educate, and train more than 4,000 at-risk children. Unfortunately, this past year gangs continue to control significant parts of Haiti's capital – Port-au-Prince. We relocated our downtown Delmas Port-au-Prince school to a safer area in the city. **We are grateful that all of our schools and orphanage facilities continue to operate and many capital projects were completed.**

Please note that our financial statement below covers only the first nine months of 2024 due to our board's move to begin our fiscal year on October 1 going forward. We are thankful that Charity Navigator, the leading U.S. non-profit rating agency, has again given us their highest rating (**4 stars**) for the 12th year in a row. We continue to value financial transparency and accountability – resulting in top honors in 2024 from the charity research firms Excellence in Giving, Great Non-Profits, and GuideStar. On average since 2002, 88 cents of every dollar donated is spent on programs directly impacting children in Haiti.

Through Christian orphanages, medical services, feeding programs, special gift outreach, and crisis relief efforts, Hope for Haiti's Children (HFHC) provides essential care for at-risk children.



62 orphaned children cared for at the Cazeau Christian orphanage

3,719 children fed in our School Lunch Program

Educate

Hope for Haiti's Children partners with ten locally operated Christian schools in Haiti to assist in the education of the students. Through the HFHC Child Education Sponsorship program, a caring sponsor financially supports a child in need. Providing tuition for students enables the school to retain quality teachers and to supply a uniform and school supplies to each student. Additionally, HFHC funds vital capital projects to enhance the learning environment of each school.

Train

Hope for Haiti's Children operates Christian leadership camps for sponsored teens as well as provides vocational training for children in orphan care. This prepares young people to lead in their homes, churches, and communities.

10 Camp Hope leaders participated in a 2-day leadership conference



39 students baptized during HFHC's Camp Hope



82 educators attended a three-day professional development workshop



30 teens received service & leadership awards at Camp Hope in 2024



13 new Spiritual Directors were hired to teach Bible classes in our schools

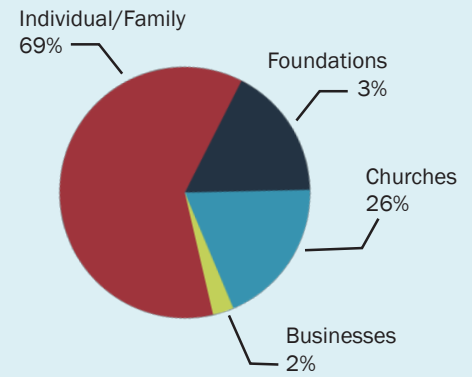


2024 PROJECT HOPE GIFT MATCH CAMPAIGN
