churches. Thanks to our Rebuilding Hope financial partners and food donations from sister organizations, we are now able to serve hot school lunches in all 10 of our sponsored schools. This is already making a difference in student attendance and academic outcomes! Also, for the second year in a row, our ministry was blessed to earn a "Perfect 100" rating by Charity Navigator, the nation's top non-profit rating agency. Less than one percent of the thousands of charities rated by this agency have earned perfect scores. This honor recognizes organizations who execute their mission in a fiscally responsible way while adhering to good governance and transparency. We are eager to continue expanding our efforts as we witness the transformative power of Christian compassion, education, and training in the lives of Haitian children trapped in deepest poverty.

Educate

Hope for Haiti's Children partners with ten locally operated Christian schools in Haiti to assist in the education of the students. Through the HFHC Child Education Sponsorship program, a caring sponsor financially supports a child in need. Providing tuition for students enables the school to retain quality teachers and to supply a uniform and school supplies to each student. Additionally, HFHC funds vital capital projects to enhance the learning environment of each school.



Hope for Haiti's Children supports after-school enrichment classes, vocational training programs, and Christian camp experiences to deepen students' knowledge base and life skills. This prepares young people to lead in their homes, churches, and communities.



220 teenagers attended Camp Hope and Youth Leadership Training Camp

9 students enrolled in post-secondary programs including Preacher Training, Solar Electricity, and Medical Technology

6 students baptized during Camp Hope

130 volunteers served at the Thomazeau Hope Center
